

COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Come Alone

We have a 5 person limit in the office at any given time, so we ask that you come alone and about 10 minutes prior to your scheduled appointment time. One person may accompany a patient requiring support (e.g. parents, mobility aide, or translator).

Please use the Health Canada approved hand sanitizer when you enter the clinic and as needed thereafter, especially after you touch your face. We also have a sink in each exam room if you prefer to wash with soap and water instead.

To protect all of us we ask that you contact our office to reschedule your appointment if you have any cold, flu, or COVID-19 symptoms.

Wear a Mask



Since we are unable to maintain the required 2 meter physical distance during your in-office eye exam, we wear masks to help protect you. We also ask that

you kindly wear a mask to help protect us. Please bring your own if you have one, otherwise we will gladly provide one for you.

Check-In

Staff may be in pretest with another patient or sanitizing an exam room when you are done your exam. For this reason, payment will be processed when you arrive so you can leave the office promptly afterwards.
